In October of 2021 Fr. Bryan was named Pastor of St. Mary in Swormville until being appointed full time in the office of Renewal in February of 2023. Growing up in Arcade NY, Fr. Bryan grew up on dairy farm with his parents and two younger brothers.

### **Dcn. John Gaulin**

is a dynamic speaker who has a way of making scripture authentic, relevant and powerful to any audience. He was ordained to the Diaconate in the Diocese of Buffalo in June, 2008. He served at the diocesan level as the founder of the Sons of St Stephen ministry, directed deacon convocations and lead parish support programs. Deacon John frequently speaks at Lenten and Advent retreats and parish missions. At the parish level, Deacon John led many programs including directing a Parish Sabbatical, numerous Adult Education programs, and heading up the parish strategic planning process.

### **Simon Peter portrayed by Mark Price**
